MA 4279/2025

M.A. 4279/2025 has been filed by the respondents seeking condonation of 17 days' delay in filing the counter affidavit. The delay is condoned in the interest of justice, and the counter affidavit is taken on record. Accordingly, M.A. 4279/2025 stands disposed of.

2. The learned counsel present submits, under instructions from the arguing counsel Mr. Devendra Kumar that all dues payable to the applicant have been received. The same is in fact even so indicated that averments in Para 3 of the counter affidavit to the effect:-

“3. XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX

*It is submitted that as the Applicant was discharged from service after completion on 24 years & 06 days of qualifying service, he has been granted 3<sup>rd</sup> MACP (Naib Subedar) vide office of the PCDA (Pension) PPO No. 167200700218 dated 05 Mar 2020 (Pay Level –L-06), which has been forwarded to the Pension Disbursing Agency of the Applicant (PDA) vide Records the Dogra Regiment letter No. Pen/3023/MACP/Gen Corres dated 27 Jun 2020 for their further necessary action.”*

3. In view of the submissions made on behalf of the applicant and the fact that all dues have been settled, the applicant seeks disposal of the matter. Accordingly, O.A. 4271/2024, along with its accompanying applications, stands disposed of, as it calls for no further action.
