This is an application filed by learned counsel for the respondents seeking modification of order passed in OA 1497/2025 on 19.05.2025 to the extent that her appearance be marked as counsel appeared on behalf of the respondents. It is submitted by learned counsel for the respondents that due to some typographical error her name is

not mentioned in the order passed on 19.05.2025 in OA 1497/2025.

4. In view of the above, we allow the application and direct that the name of Ms. Nehal Jain, Advocate be read as counsel for the respondents in the order passed in OA 1497/2025 on 19.05.2025.

Invoking the jurisdiction of this Tribunal under Section 14 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007, the applicant had filed this application and the relief claimed in para 8 is to set aside the impugned order passed on 13.01.2025 rejecting the prayer of the applicant for grant of Pre-mature retirement on compassionate grounds. Even though respondents have filed the counter affidavit, today during the course of hearing learned counsel for the applicant submits that, as the applicant has been granted pre-mature retirement on compassionate ground this application is now rendered infructuous.

7. Accordingly, in view of the relief granted by the respondents themselves, this application rendered

infructuous. However, prior to discharge if on account of any adverse action taken against the applicant, any grievance still subsists, the applicant shall have the liberty to ventilate the same in accordance with law.

8. OA stands disposed of.

9. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stands closed.
