Today when the case was taken up for hearing, it has been argued by Mr. SS Pandey, learned Counsel for the applicant that the case involves a simple issue to be adjudicated as the applicant has been subjected to discriminatory approach by the PCDA.

- 2. We have perused the impugned letter of Department of Ex-Servicemen Welfare/D (Pension Grievances), Government of India, Ministry of Defence dated 21.09.2021 denying DA on pension to the applicant on the grounds that he is re employed in Institute of Liver & Biliary Sciences (ILBS) and therefore is not entitled to DA.
- 3. However, having gone through the letter of his appointment, we observe that he has been employed on a contractual basis and not on re-employment basis by ILBS. We

note that the applicant has also cited cases of similarly placed

employees placed at Page No 63 who are employed on contract

basis in the same organisation and are drawing the DA on

pension. Let a copy of the list of such employees placed at

Annexure A-18 in the OA be served to the office of the PCDA by

the Ld Sr CGSC for the Respondents No 1 & 2. We direct the

PCDA to show cause as to why such a benefit should be denied to

the applicant which is being allowed to similarly placed

employees.

4. PCDA(P), i. e. Respondent No 3 is directed to place their

response through a short affidavit before us within four weeks,

failing which, we shall proceed ex parte on this matter.

5. List the matter on 3rd April, 2025.

6. Let a copy of this order be given 'DASTI' to both the parties.
