Six weeks' time, as prayed for, is granted to the respondents for the purpose of issuance of PPO in the case of 11 applicants in whose cases the Government Sanction has been received and the benefit has to be conferred on them. In the case of the remaining applicants, it is the case of the respondents that they are not entitled to claim the benefit and, therefore, they propose to pass a speaking order in their case within six weeks.

2. It may be noted that in all such cases where we are allowing the petition on the very first date at the stage of admission, without notice to the respondents, if in any of the matters pertaining to grant of increment or pay fixation, the respondents feel that for certain reasons the applicant (s) is not entitled to the relief claimed, in such cases the respondents are fee

to pass a speaking order and communicate the same to the applicant(s) and it is not necessary to file a review application in all such matters.

2. Put up again on 9th December, 2024.
