On the last date of hearing respondents produced a Corrigendum PPO to say that the benefit accruing to the applicant by virtue of the Order passed in the OA has been granted to the applicant. However, learned counsel for the applicant, on instructions, pursuant to the directions passed on 17.09.2025 informs us that the benefit granted to the applicant by the aforesaid PPO is nothing but payment of benefit of OROP to the applicant. However, the benefit of stepping up of pay at par with the junior of the applicant and complying with the directions issued by this Tribunal in the OA has not been done.

2. On query being made to the representative from the office of PCDA(P), Prayagraj, it is informed that the requisite

papers for issuance of PPO in compliance with the Order passed by this Tribunal in the OA has not been received from the office concerned of the Indian Air Force. In view of the same, it is stated that the PCDA(P), Prayagraj is unable to issue PPO to the applicant.

3. Taking note of the aforesaid aspect of the matter and the fact that on the last date of hearing just to say compliance has been done by producing a PPO which has nothing to do with the Order passed by this Tribunal, we direct the respondents to ensure issuance of PPO to the applicant in compliance to the Order passed in the OA within four weeks from today, failing which, the officer concerned dealing with the issue shall remain present before this Tribunal on the next date.

4. List the matter on 04.12.2025.
