Four weeks time is sought by the respondents to file the counter affidavit which be so filed accordingly. However, in view of the prayers that have been made in the OA which indicate that the applicant virtually seeks condonation of shortfall of 22 days of qualifying service for grant of MACPs to the applicant, the matter being *sub judice* in OA 2679/2021 and OA 2453/2024 before the Larger Bench *qua* the issue whether the condonation of shortfall can be allowed for the purpose of grant of MACP in view of the Regulation 18 of the Pension Regulations for the Army, 2008 (Part-I), the matter be re-notified by the Registry after disposal of the said issue by the Larger Bench.
