The learned Counsel for the Applicant has contended that the Applicant who had joined service with the Respondent on 6<sup>th</sup> of June, 1981 has been relieved from service on compassionate ground upon the request of the Applicant on 30.11.1989 on the ground that he had suffered disability with regard to hearing impairment and has been categorised by the Release Medical Board in Medical Low Category CEE (Permanent) which was occurred during service and is attributable and aggravated by Military service.
2. Learned Counsel for the Applicant has contended that in pursuance to the letter dated 19.11.2017 issued by the Government of India, Ministry of Defence, the pre 2006 retirees are also entitled to the benefit of disability element of pension.
