1. This is a third round of litigation initiated by the Applicant. The Applicant had prayed for quashing of order dated 23.03.2011 and 31.10.2011 and also for quashing the order of dismissal. He had prayed for conversion of order of dismissal into discharge and grant pension as allegedly he had rendered more than 15 years of service. The Applicant had earlier filed a writ petition in High Court of Delhi which was disposed of vide order dated 30.10.2002, a copy of which is placed at page 47 of the OA. Thereafter, he filed another writ petition in the Patna High Court which was also disposed of vide order dated 11.05.2016 which is placed at page 49 of the OA, holding that the Applicant may approach the Armed Forces Tribunal, for redressal of his grievance, as at that time, the AFT Act, 2007 came into operation.

2. In addition to this, the Applicant had also approached the Hon'ble President of India as well as the National Human Rights Commission. The Order passed on the basis of the complaint made

to the Human Rights Commission is placed at page 18. Before the Tribunal pass any further order on the application, the learned Counsel for the Applicant seeks time to place all the material documents including the petition addressed to the Hon'ble President of India as well as the order in writ petition filed in Delhi High Court.

3. Let the Applicant place on record all the relevant documents with a period of eight weeks from today.
