Invoking the jurisdiction of this Tribunal u/s 14, grievance of the applicant is that the request made by the applicant for premature separation from service on extreme compassionate ground under para 19(c) of the HRP Part (1)/PO/PR/02/2018 submitted vide annexure A-1 on 25.10.2024 has not been decided and therefore, the applicant prays that a direction be issued to the respondents for grant of PMR to the applicant and consider the case of the applicant for immediate release. On advance notice, learned counsel for the respondents informs us that the issue of premature separation under the policy in the Indian Air Force is decided by a Competent Board constituted for the said purpose. The Board normally meets twice a year in the month of October and March and all cases of PMR are considered by the said Board. It is stated that the next Board is to meet in March, 2025 and the case of the applicant shall be considered by

the said Board. Keeping in view the aforesaid we direct that the matter be listed in the first week of April, 2025. The application of the applicant annexure A-1 be placed before the Board to be held in March, 2025 and a decision taken in accordance with law be communicated to the applicant.

2. List the matter on 04.04.2025.
3. Let a copy of this order be given '***DASTT***' to both the parties.
