He further requests that he wants to withdraw the present application and looking to the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case, Respondent side be directed to dispose of the statutory complaint of the Petitioner expeditiously preferably within a period of two weeks.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the Respondents sub

Petitioner files statutory complaint before the concerned authorit

disposed of expeditiously within a reasonable time.

Considering the submissions of the learned counsel for the Petitioner and

looking to the facts of the case, Petitioner is permitted to withdraw the

present application with the liberty to file fresh application as and when

required. He is also free to file statutory complaint before the concerned

authority. Respondent side is directed to dispose of statutory complaint, if

any filed by the Petitioner expeditiously preferably within a period of four

weeks.

Looking to the facts and circumstances of the case, present application is

dismissed as withdrawn.
