Petitioner contended that though he is dismissed from service but he has served for 17 ½ years. So he may be granted some post retrial benefits. We are of the opinion that the offence for which petitioner was charged is of such serious nature in which this Tribunal is not inclined to interfere. The Government after examining the case has declined to grant any post retrial benefits to the petitioner in view of conduct of petitioner. Hence, we are not inclined to interfere in the matter. Consequently, same is dismissed with no order as to costs.
