Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

After seeing the report given on 13th May 2009 in which the Department of Gastroenterology Base Hospital Delhi Cantt says that "Stomach: post GJ Status with few erosions on folds and near stroma. Duodenal bulb: normal. D2: normal. Both loops: normal" still the petitioner submits that he has problem and he is not fully cured. His disability pension was stopped in 1994 on finding that his disability has gone below 20%. Petitioner still feels that he is not normal. Therefore, if he makes a request for re-examination by the Medical Board on such request he may be re-examined and if his disability persists then his case may be dealt with accordingly.

With these observations, the petition is disposed of with no order as to costs.
