ORDER 11.01.2011

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the order passed by the authorities and it appears that the petitioner cannot get two benefits. He cannot get the benefit of the insurance and also order of reinstatement. The order is very clear that in case he deposits the entire amount he will get the due benefits of reinstatement or otherwise not. The view is correct. So far as question of grant of disability pension is concerned we are satisfied that all the three diseases which he set to be suffering from has nothing to do with the army service.

Consequently there is no ground for interference and the matter is dismissed. No order as to costs.
