Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

Petitioner has been discharged being an alcoholic. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has put in 14 years and 4 months of service and he is only short by 8 months for making a full pensionable service. Since the petitioner has already been discharged from service being alcoholic and he has put in 14 years and 4 months of service and he is short of only 8 months for completing 15 years of service, petitioner should make a representation to the respondents and we hope and trust that the respondents will consider the matter sympathetically for condoning this period for completion of 15 years of service to qualify him for pensionable service.

With these observations, the petition is disposed of with no order as to costs.
