The petitioner was commissioned on 17.12.1993 and he was posted to Project Himank at Leh from 17.6.2008 from 17.6.2008 and he has claimed compensatory field area allowance but the same was not granted to the petitioner by the respondents. So he has filed this petition and submitted that this issue has already been decided by the coordinating Bench in the case of Col. G. L. N. Keshav Vs. UOI & Ors. bearing T. A. No. 87 of 2009 decided on 25.2.2010. In the light of the said judgment, the petitioner is also entitled to compensatory field area allowance. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the above said decision given by the coordinating Bench. In view of the same, the petition is allowed and the petitioner may be given all the consequential benefits as directed by the coordinating Bench in the above said case. No order as to costs.
