1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner.
2. The Petitioner was discharged in 1978. Petitioner has now filed this petition in 2011 when almost more than 33 years have elapsed. The limitation is prescribed in the Act. Therefore, we cannot condone this inordinate delay for granting a relief to the Petitioner. In this connection, learned counsel for the Petitioner has invited our attention to the decision in the case of **Union of India v. Tarsem Singh 2008(8) SCC 648**. But looking to the inordinate delay in the matter, we are not inclined to interfere with this extremely belated petition. The petition is dismissed with no order as to costs.
