The Petitioner is making a grievance that he should be granted service pension waiving the delay of 101 days out of 10 years of service with effect from 19<sup>th</sup> September 1974 when he was discharged from service. This petition in 2011 is extremely belated and it cannot be entertained. Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that he has filed an appeal in 2008 which is still pending with the Respondents. We are not concerned with that as the Petitioner has been discharged way back in 1974 and he is now ventilating his grievance in 2011.

2. Consequently, the petition is extremely belated and it cannot be entertained and the same is dismissed with no order as to costs.
