Heard and perused the record.

During the course of submissions, learned counsel for the applicant submitted that while disposing of applicant's statutory complaint, ACP order granting him financial benefit has been passed but that has not yet been implemented. He also submitted a copy of the PPO order dated 18.02.2010. Learned counsel for the respondents also agrees to this extent that this order is to be implemented and a request is made to grant reasonable time to implement the said order.

Considering the submissions from both sides, two months time is granted to respondent side to implement the ACP order. After implementation of the ACP order, if any other grievance of the applicant is left, he is free to file representation with the concerned authority. This order will not come in his way. Further, applicant is also free to approach this tribunal if the order is not implemented within the stipulated time.

In view of above, now nothing remains to be adjudicated in the present case. Accordingly, application is disposed of. File be consigned to Record Room. No order as to costs.
