ORDER

1. Petitioner by this petition is challenging the order dated 7th May 1986, order dated 1st December 1987 and order dated 20th September 2010.
2. The incumbent was discharged on his own request way back in 1986 and now he has come up after filing a representation in 2010. This kind of a belated petition cannot be entertained.
3. Secondly, learned counsel for the petitioner has said in the petition that he has received a gun shot bone injury during the Blue Star Operation. No such evidence has been placed on record to show that he received such gun shot injury during the Blue Star Operation. Therefore, we cannot accede to this belated petition on a ground which is not substantiated by medical evidence.

4. Consequently, the petition is dismissed with no order as to costs.
