So far as the challenge to the policy is concerned, we do not think it can be acceded to as there is no violation of Sections 14 and 16 so as to declare the said policy ultra vires of the Constitution. However, if he makes a legitimate grievance before the Government then the Government may pass appropriate orders in accordance with law.
