Heard and perused the record.

During the course of submissions, learned counsel for the applicant states that the applicant was granted commission of Hony. Lieutenant on 26.01.2011 in stead of 15.08.2010 and by this action the applicant has been deprived of his legitimate right of promotion to the rank of Hony. Captain resulting in financial losses. He submits that the applicant is writing again and again to the respondents, but to no avail. Now, applicant wants to file statutory complaint/representation again for consideration.

At this stage, learned counsel for the applicant submits that he may be permitted to withdraw this O.A. with liberty to file statutory complaint/representation before the respondents and requests that respondents be directed to dispose of the same within the stipulated period.

Considering the submission of learned counsel for the applicant and looking to the facts of the case, the applicant is permitted to withdraw the present O.A. with the aforesaid liberty to file statutory complaint/ representation before the respondents within 15 days and if the same is filed the respondents are directed to disposed of the same preferably within a period of six months. The applicant will be free to agitate the outcome of the representation, if he so wishes. The filing of this O.A. will not come in the way in dealing with statutory complaint/ representation.

O.A. stands disposed of.
