ORDER

1. Learned counsel for the Respondents submits that the authorities have instructed him to make a statement that the Petitioner will be allowed to continue till his date of completion of his tenure i.e. retirement which is 30th June 2012. Therefore the first relief sought by Petitioner stands already allowed by the Respondents.

2. Learned counsel for the Petitioner has now submitted that he has also prayed that in continuity of service till date of superannuation the Petitioner may be permitted promotions at par with his batch mates as though there was no break up in service. Learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that unless he passes the promotion cadre course he may not be promoted. Let the Respondents may consider the case of the Petitioner in accordance with law. The authorities will consider the matter sympathetically. With this observation, the petition is disposed of. No order as to costs.
