Heard and perused the record.

In pursuance of our direction given on 15.03.2012 learned counsel for the respondents states that the Last Pay Certificate (LPC) has already been issued on 29.03.2012 and has been addressed to the office of Director of Accounts, Nagpur, but they considered not to supply that copy of the same to the applicant. He further stated that vide letter dated 22.05.2012 the LPC has been addressed to the HRO Accounts, AML Pension, New Delhi along with one copy of the same to the applicant.

Learned counsel for the applicant states that due to non-availability of the LPC the applicant has been deprived from pay and allowances as well as other requisite formalities like deposition of LIC premium. A request is made that it is a proper case, where cost be imposed on the respondents for not supplying the copy of the LPC to applicant.

Considering facts of the case and the submissions made by learned counsel for the applicant, we direct that in future copy of the LPC be immediately issued to the concerned personnel on their transfer. Further, considering facts of the case, nothing further survives in the matter and as we have not issued notice to the respondents, matter has become infructuous.

Case is disposed of accordingly.
