ORDER

1. Petitioner by this petition has prayed that the Respondents may be directed to grant ordinary family pension (though she has claimed special family pension) in full, alongwith every fiscal benefit.
2. Respondents 1 to 3 in their reply have already mentioned that PPO has been issued in the name of the mother of the deceased Rifleman Jasbir. In view of this, nothing survives in this petition and same is disposed of.
3. The Petitioner has also impleaded AGI as a party to the petition but AGI is not subject to jurisdiction of this Tribunal. Therefore, the Petitioner may approach the appropriate forum for adjudication of his rights qua AGI.

4. With these observations, the petition is disposed of. No order as to costs.
