For future guidance, petitioner is also directed to intimate the CDA, Pune regarding change of his bank from Union Bank of India to State Bank of India in writing so that in future such kind of confusion does not arise.

Petition is disposed with these observations. Copy of order be given dasti to all the parties as prayed.
