ORDER

1. The petitioner by this petition has prayed that the order dated 11<sup>th</sup> June 2010 may be set aside and the respondents may be directed to dispose of the statutory complaint of the Petitioner on priority basis but not later than 15 days.
2. We do not propose to go into the merits of the matter. Suffice it to say that since the statutory complaint was filed by the Petitioner in the month of October 2010 which is pending with the Respondents against the severe displeasure recorded and same has not been disposed of and petitioner's promotion board is likely to meet shortly. Therefore in these circumstances it is prayed that petitioner's statutory complaint may be disposed of within four weeks as far as possible so that before the promotion board meets he will know its fate. The respondents are directed that the statutory complaint filed by the petitioner in October 2010 shall be disposed of within four weeks

before the convening of the selection board for the post of the Brigadier. With this observation, the petition is accordingly disposed of. No order as to costs.
