- 1. Petitioner by this petition has prayed that Respondents may be directed for holding their decision on the appeal submitted by one Ms. Anju Bala, D/o Sh. Bhagmal, vide her letter dated 26th July 2011 wherein she has claimed 50 percent share in the monthly salary of the Petitioner and to record her name in the service record of the Petitioner as his legally wedded wife till the final disposal of the case pending in the Court of Sh. Deepak Jagotra, Judge Family Court, Dwarka, New Delhi vide HMA No. 2206 of 2011 in the matter of Mulkh Raj v. Anju Bala & Anr. under Section 11 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 for the annulment of ceremonies and marriage being void.
- 2. So far as the present case is concerned, the Respondents have filed their reply and they have also admitted that they will not pass any order without hearing the Petitioner on the application filed by Ms. Anju Bala. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the Respondents that no order will be passed without hearing the Petitioner on application filed by Ms.

Anju Bala, nothing survives in this petition. The Respondents shall before passing any order on the application filed by Ms. Anju Bala give a proper hearing to the Petitioner also.

 With this observation the petition stands disposed of. No order as to costs.
