Heard and perused the record.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that in compliance of previous order as per instructions and record apprehension roll has been cancelled and the applicant has been declared deserter w.e.f. 27.05.1996 and just after expiry of three years his name has been struck off from the deserter roll. She further states that the applicant has been dismissed from service w.e.f. 18.10.1999 vide letter dated 22.10.1999.

Learned counsel for the respondents also produced letter dated 27.01.2012 in this respect intimating the same fact and also one letter issued by Air Headquarters, Vayu Bhawan, New Delhi dated 27.01.2012 to the name of the Superintendent of Police, District Sikar, Rajasthan intimating that in view of the striking off the name of the applicant from the strength, he ceases to be liable for apprehension for

the offences of desertion from Indian Air Force. She further states that now there is no apprehension of arrest by the police concerned. She requests that the discharge certificate, if applied as per procedure, will be supplied to the applicant.

Considering submissions made by learned counsel for the respondents, the learned counsel for the applicant does not want to press this applicant. The same is disposed of, accordingly.
