By virtue of provision under Section 3 (o) (iv) (ii) of The Armed Forces

Tribunal Act 2007, the petitioner seeks to go back to his regiment for the
reasons mentioned by him in the petition. That cannot be entertained by this

Tribunal by virtue of prohibition already contained in the aforesaid provision
which reads as under;

"3. (o) (iv) (ii)

but shall not include matters relating to-

(ii) transfers and postings including the change of place or unit on posting whether individually or as a part of unit, formation or ship in relation to the persons subject to the Army Act, 1950 (45 of 1950), the Navy Act, 1957 (62 of 1957) and the Air Force Act, 1950 (45 of 1950)"

Therefore, in these circumstances, this petition for transfer cannot be entertained. Consequently same is dismissed.
