The applicant has filed the above OA for issue of directions to the respondents to grant him disability pension. The application is accompanied by MA 259/2016 to condone the delay of 17 years, 4 months and 5 days.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the parties and perused the application for condonation of delay. Having regard to the settled position that claim for pension is a continuous cause of action and relying on the judgment of the Apex Court ***Union of India and Others Vs. Tarsem Singh (2008) 8 SCC 648*** we hold that the delay involved required to be condoned with rider in case the petitioner succeeds, the arrears of pension to assess the disability will be restricted to a period of three years prior to the filing of the application subject to the filing of application. Delay is condoned. The MA stands allowed.
