Heard Mr. VS Kadian, the learned counsel for the applicant and Mr Prabodh Kumar, the learned counsel for the respondents.

2. Having heard the learned counsel for the parties and upon perusal of the averments made in the application, we are of the considered view that since the claim for pension is based on a continuing cause of action, which arises every month, the MA needs to be disposed of with the observation that if the applicant is found to be entitled to the relief as claimed in the OA, arrear may be restricted for a period of three years preceding the date of filing of the OA.

3. The MA accordingly stands disposed of.


Heard Mr. V.S. Kadian, learned counsel for the applicant.
