The respondents has filed MA 1769/2023 praying for grant of leave for impugning the orders dated 29.08.2022 to the Hon'ble Supreme Court in terms of Section 31 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007. There being delay in filing

the aforesaid application, an application for condonation of delay being MA 1770/2023 has been filed.

Heard. Apart from the fact that there is inordinate delay of 204 days in filing the application seeking leave to appeal, no point of law much less any point of law of general public importance involved in the orders and, therefore, prayer for grant of leave to appeal is rejected.
