Through the medium of instant application, the applicant – Union of India seeks grant of leave to appeal under Sections 30 and 31 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007, before the Hon'ble Supreme Court for throwing challenge to the judgment dated 14th November, 2022 passed in the OA 2016/2022.
