In pursuance to the bailable warrant issued on 6th November, 2023 on behalf of respondents No. 4 an application for cancellation of the bailable warrant has been filed and we are informed by learned counsel for the applicant in MA No. 1199/2022 that he has received a short affidavit wherein respondents No. 4 has given details pertaining to the compliance of the order passed and crediting the amount into the applicant's account, as indicated in the PPO, and with regard to certain other amount remaining to be credited, it is indicated that the Central Bank of India has to comply with the said order. Even though a copy of the said short affidavit has been served on learned counsel for the applicant but no such affidavit is available on record.

2. Taking note of the aforesaid facts, which have been brought to our notice, we allow and dispose of MA 5443/2023 and for

the present, the personal appearance of respondents No. 4 is dispensed with. However, respondents No. 4 be noticed to bring on record the copy of the short affidavit filed, as indicated by learned counsel for the applicant and ensure that they are represented by counsel on the next date.

3. List the MA 1199/2022 on 9th February, 2024.

4. In the meanwhile, learned counsel for the applicant may give us details of the Central Bank of India which has to comply with part of the order so that appropriate orders can be issued to the Central Bank of India.

5. That apart respondents No. 4 is directed to produce calculation sheet with regard to the amount credited in the applicant's account. Let a copy of this order be forwarded by the Principal Registrar of this Tribunal to respondents No. 4. We also direct learned counsel for the applicant to serve a copy of this order on respondents No. 4 office so that the respondent No. 4 take action in the matter.

6. Let a copy of this order be provided '*DASTI*' to both the parties.
