


Seeking compliance of an order passed by this Tribunal in O.A No. 1444 of 2022 in the matter of granting pensionary benefits to the applicant, this application has been filed.

2. On 28.08.2023, even though PPO was issued by the Pension Payment Authority but considering the fact that the applicant was a resident of Nepal, the amount could not be credited to his bank account for want of certain procedural formalities to be completed. Thereafter, the matter was referred to the Indian Embassy at Nepal for taking of action. On 06.12.2023, a letter has been received from the Embassy of India, Defence Wing, Military Pension Branch, Kathmandu (Nepal) addressed to the Principal Registrar in reference to his communication made, it is indicated that the second pension to the applicant has been

commenced and pension with effect from 01.06.2019 is being granted and arrears have also been granted the amount is being credited to the applicant's pension account held in the State Bank of India Ltd Nepal Branch:

3. Taking note of the information received from the Defence Wing of the Embassy of India, Kathmandu we find that the entire directions contained in the order passed by this Tribunal have been complied with and supporting documents are also available in the communication received on 12.12.2023.
4. Accordingly, finding the order to have been complied with, the matter stands closed and the application is disposed of.
