Learned counsel for the respondents is granted further four weeks' time to comply with the order passed in OA 3674/2023.

MA 2130/2024

This application has been filed for clarification to the fact that the period between 16.12.2009 to 01.06.2014 when the applicant had not worked after non grant of extension of Short Service Commission be treated as no work no wages and as the

order passed by this Tribunal in OA 3674/2023 dt. 24.11.2023 does not clarify this position, the application has been filed. In our considered view this was not at all necessary. While deciding the OA 3674/2023, we had followed the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court and the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the order itself had clarified with the interim period would be treated on the basis of no work no wages. That being so, such clarification was not necessary, however, as the respondent has sought for the clarification, we direct that for the interim period the applicant shall not be entitled for any arrear. It shall be treated as no work no wages.

2. Accordingly, the MA stands as disposed of.
