The applicant has filed this application, i.e., MA 2704/2024, praying for grant of leave for impugning the order dated 25.05.2022 passed in OA 1100/2022 to the Hon'ble Supreme Court in terms of Section 30 & 31 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007. There being a delay of 633 days, MA 2705/2024 has also been filed seeking condonation in filing this application.

2. Having heard applicant in person, we find no point of law much less any point of law of general public importance involved in the matter. There is also no satisfactory explanation for the delay of 633 days. Hence the ~~prayer~~^{prayer} for

leave to appeal is declined both on the grounds of merit and delay.

3. Accordingly, the MAs stand dismissed.
