

In reply to the notice issued, the respondents have indicated by way of an affidavit that the pay of the applicant has already been fixed in the most beneficial option available and therefore nothing further remains to be done in the matter. We are in the agreement with the aforesaid contention of the respondents, the OA was disposed of by this Tribunal on the very first date based on the law laid down in the case of Sub M. L. Shrivastava Vs. Union of India and Ors.(OA 1182/2018) decided on 03.09.2021. subject to verification by the respondents and now respondents have given justification for not granting the pay fixation benefit to the applicant for reasons indicated in the affidavit filed on 21st July, 2024. We see no reason to proceed in the matter

and dispose of the application. The proceedings are closed. In case the applicant has any grievance in the matter of his pay fixation on transition from 6th CPC to 7th CPC, he may have liberty to challenge the same in accordance with law.

2. With the aforesaid, MA stands disposed of.
