Vide order passed on 8th September, 2022, the OA No.1983/2022 was allowed. Thereafter, when the order was not implemented, the applicant filed MA 424/2023 and during the pendency of the matter, the respondents issued the PPO and based on the same MA 424/2023 was disposed of directing State Bank of India, respondents No. 5 and 6 in the OA, to credit the amount in the Bank account of the applicant and ensure that the benefits accruing to the applicant are paid accordingly.

2. With the aforesaid, the application was disposed of and it was also directed that in case the Bank does not comply with order liberty was available to the applicant to seek

revival of MA 424/2023. More than six months have passed but the respondents (Bank) have not credited the amount into the account of the applicant. That being so, this application has been filed for revival of MA 424/2023.

3. Taking note of the facts and circumstances of the case MA 314/2024 is allowed and MA 424/2023 is restored to its original file and the same be listed for hearing on 26th April, 2024.

4. On filing of process fee within one week, notice shall be issued to Respondents No.5 and 6. Notice be issued to respondents No. 5 and 6 directing them to show cause as to why the action should not be taken against them for disobedience of the order passed by this Tribunal on 17th August, 2023 in MA 424/2023.

5. List the matter on 26th April, 2024
