The prayer made in this application purportedly having being filed under Section 31 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007, seeks leave to appeal for challenging the order passed by this Tribunal in OA 832/2015 on 25.07.2023 and in RA 61/2023 with MA 457/2024 in OA 832/2015 on 29.08.2024 to the Hon'ble High Court, New Delhi.

2. There is no provision under law or under constitution or under the statute for seeking leave to appeal to file writ petition in the Hon'ble High Court under Article 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India.

3. Under Section 31 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007, leave to appeal can be granted by this Tribunal only for the purpose of filing a Special Leave Petition (SLP) in

the Hon'ble Supreme Court. That being so, this application, being not maintainable in accordance with the law, stands dismissed.

4. Accordingly, the MA stands disposed of.
