Invoking the jurisdiction of this Tribunal under Section 14 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007, the applicant has filed this application challenging the order dated 08.02.2024 (Annexure-A1), whereby the application for discharge/resignation submitted on 20.09.2023 by the applicant was rejected. However, after issuance of notice and during the pendency of the matter, learned counsel for the applicant has stated that the applicant was directed by the Competent Authority to submit a fresh application seeking discharge/resignation, which the applicant submitted in the last week of July 2024. The applicant would be satisfied if the second application submitted in July 2024 is considered and disposed of in accordance with law within a reasonable period.

2. In view of the above, it is directed that if any application for discharge/resignation has been submitted by the applicant in July 2024, the same shall be considered in accordance with the applicable rules, and a decision shall be taken within a period of two months from today.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant is directed to supply a copy of the application submitted by the applicant in July 2024 to the learned Sr. CGSC for the respondents within the next three days.

4. In light of the above, the OA stands disposed of, granting liberty to the applicant to approach this Tribunal again if he remains aggrieved by the decision.
