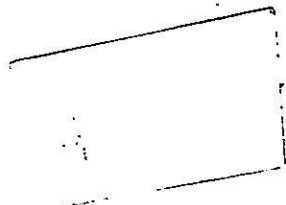

Even though the matter is listed today under the heading of 'Not to be taken up', on a mentioning made by Mr. Rajiv Manglik, learned counsel appearing for the applicant, the matter is taken up.

2. It is pointed out by Mr. Manglik that the applicant (Col Surinder Pal Singh (Retd)) is no more alive and after he got information about his death, he had contacted his legal heirs for filing appropriate application for bringing the legal representatives on record. He has also produced a copy of e-mail sent by him to the legal representatives of the original applicant and points out that he has not received any response to the same, and, therefore, he is unable to take further action in the matter.



3. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and no steps having been taken after the death of the applicant, the proceedings in the OA stand abated and the OA is disposed of accordingly. However, liberty shall be available to the legal heirs of the applicant to seek setting aside of the abatement and restoration of OA after they are brought on record. A copy of e-mail sent by Mr. Rajiv Manglik, learned counsel for the applicant, is kept on record.

4. OA stands disposed of with the liberty aforesaid.
