Seeking implementation of an order passed by this Tribunal in OA 1481/2024 in the matter grant of one notional increment, this application has been filed seeking execution. GSL was issued by competent authority for implementation of the order passed by this Tribunal and the documents along with and the GSL was forwarded to the office of PCDA (P) Prayagraj for necessary compliance.

2. Today, representative from the office of PCDA (P) Prayagraj produces before us an order dated 21.08.2025 issued by the office of PCDA indicating that on scrutiny of the claim of the applicant it is found that the basic pay of the applicant mentioned in the LPC datasheet is Rs. 40,400/- which includes one notional increment added on 1st July, 2019 and accordingly, it is stated that the applicant having received the increment

on 1st July, 2019, nothing further survives in the matter and all benefits accruing to the applicant have already been granted. A perusal of the order passed by us on 07.05.2025 also indicates that the applicant was directed to be paid one notional increment, for the service rendered from 01st July, 2018 to 30th June 2019 and, therefore, the increment in question, would have fallen due on 1st July, 2019 after the increment that fall due on 1st July, 2019 has already been paid to the applicant as indicated by the Pension Paying Authority namely, PCDA(P) Prayagraj nothing survives in the matter as the benefit has already been granted.

3. The application stands disposed of.

4. However, if the applicant has any grievance still subsists in the matter with regard to the aforesaid aspect, liberty shall be available to him to invoke the jurisdiction of an appropriate forum and claim the benefits.
