It is a common ground that the benefit accruing to the applicant by virtue of the order passed in OA 1234/2017 along with arrears have been paid to the applicant and, therefore, on merit nothing further survives in this application.

2. However, learned counsel for the applicant makes a statement to say that the breakup of the benefit granted to the applicant and the various heads on which the calculation of amount have been done may be provided to the applicant so that she can verify the same and, if required, prosecute the matter any further. The prayer seems to be reasonable and,

therefore, the respondents and particularly the office of PCDA (P), Prayagraj is directed to ensure that the breakup of the amount paid to the applicant and details of the same are provided to the applicant within four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

3. In view of the above, the MA stands disposed of.
4. Let a copy of this order be served on the representative from the office of PCDA (P), Prayagraj who is present in the Court today and he should ensure that the directions to provide the information to the applicant regarding the payment made should be supplied within four weeks.
