We have taken note of the submissions made on behalf of the respondents through their affidavit filed today in MA No.4663/2024 that there is no disparity in the CRs earned by the officer serving under civilian officer or military officer. It is also affirmed that the mathematical correction of difference of 0.03 marks in favour of the CR earned by the officer under Military Officer is already enshrined in the mathematical model to cater for the uniformity. We, therefore, find no reason to continue with our direction to withhold MS Branch Policy letter No A/17151/4/MS/CR Policy dated 06.04.2021 and accordingly in partial modification of our order

dated 04.10.2024, the restrictions thus imposed are hereby lifted.

2. Having noted the aforesaid, we direct the respondents to execute the directions at Para 64 and 65 of our orders on the OA No.246/2024 and consider the applicant for NDC Course selection scheduled later this month.

3. Accordingly, the MA stands disposed of.
