Heard learned counsel for the parties on the MA.

2. In the matter of granting notional increment to the applicant based on the law laid down by the Hon'ble High Court of Madras in the case of P. Ayyamperumal Vs. The Registrar, Central Administrative Tribunal, Madras Bench and Ors. (WP No.15732/2017 decided on 15.09.2017), at the instant of the applicant in OA 386/2023, we had directed the respondents to take note of the law laid down by the Hon'ble High Court of Madras in the case of P. Ayyamperumal (supra) and decide the claim of the applicant with regard to notional increment within a period of four months. When nothing was done and the period of four months elapsed, a prayer under Section 29 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007 by filing MA 2136/2024 is made

seeking execution of an order passed on 10.02.2023 in OA 386/2023.

3. Thereafter, MA 2136/2024 vide order dated 09.05.2025 was disposed of directing the respondents to settle the claim of the applicant in the light of the order passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court on 06.09.2024 and clause (d) thereof further modified on 20.02.2025 in MA Diary No.2400/2024 in Civil Appeal No.3933/2023 titled Union of India & Anr. Vs. M. Siddaraj. However, the respondents have not taken any action even though the period of four months have elapsed and, therefore, a prayer under Rule 25 of the Armed Forces Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 2008 by filing this application is made seeking restoration of the MA 2136/2024.

4. Keeping in view the aforesaid, we allow this application and restore MA 2136/2024 to its original file.
