Mr. Digvijay Singh, learned counsel for the Punjab National Bank points out that arrears of Rs. 4,91,117/- have been paid to the applicant on 14.02.2025 and submits that in view of the said payment and the compliance affidavit filed by the Bank on 27.03.2024, nothing survives in the matter now and the applicant is not entitled to any further benefit.

2. Taking note of the aforesaid compliance reported by the respondents, we see no reason to keep this miscellaneous application for execution pending. The application is disposed of; however, in case the applicant has any grievance subsisting after the compliance made as indicated hereinabove, liberty shall be available to the applicant to file

a fresh application for execution in accordance with law for further directions.
