When the matter is taken up for admission Shri Karan Singh Bhati, Sr. CGSC points out that the summary trial in the matter has been concluded and the applicant has been punished with dismissal and 90 days Rigorous Imprisonment (RI). He has also stated that all the documents have been given to the applicant. Shri Kakkar, learned counsel for the applicant refutes the aforesaid and submits that except for one document indicating the punishment imposed, no document has been supplied to the applicant.

2. Be that as it may be, now as the final order has been passed in the summary trial and the applicant has been punished, the applicant is required to challenge the said punishment in accordance with law. However, Shri Kakkar submits that the applicant has been punished with 90 days RI of which he has

already undergone custody of 60 days and now for undergoing the remaining 30 days custody, he is being transferred to civil jail. He prays for grant of bail.

3. Under these circumstances, as this application is not for grant of bail and bail can be granted only in exercise of the powers conferred upon us under Section 15 (1) of AFT Act, 2007 after trial, we direct Shri Kakkar to file an appeal under Section 15 (1) and also challenge the punishment imposed. He is granted time to do so. The documents as are necessary for defending the applicant and which are to be supplied to him in accordance with rules, should be supplied to the applicant, immediately, if not already done.

4. This application stands disposed of with liberty to the applicant to file an appropriate application under Section 15 seeking bail and other relief in view of the subsequent developments.

5. Order **dasti**.
