Considering the fact that the grievance of the applicant with regard to the non-grant of Discharge Book in respect of service rendered by the applicant has already been decided by this Tribunal in OA 735/2025 vide order dated 26.03.2025, again an application under Section 14 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007, for the same relief is not maintainable. In case the respondents have not issued the Discharge Book in spite of the order passed on 26.03.2025 in OA 735/2025, the applicant may file an execution application indicating steps taken by him for implementation of the order in OA 735/2025 and seek appropriate orders in the execution application.

- 2. With the aforesaid liberty to the applicant, the matter stands disposed of. However, in the meanwhile, respondents are directed to take note of the grievance of the applicant and ensure compliance of the directions issued in the previous OA, i.e., OA 735/2025.
- 3. Accordingly, the OA stands dismissed as withdrawn.
- 4. In view of the order passed in the OA, MA 3712/2025 stands disposed of.
