Counter affidavit of the respondents is on the record. No rejoinder is sought to be filed by the applicant.

It is submitted by counsel for the applicant that the three applicants now confine their prayers to the extent of grant of the OROP benefits to them which were denied to them in as much as they had sought premature voluntary retirement and that they seek the grant of the OROP benefits in terms of the order dated 31.01.2025 in OA 313/2022 and that no further prayers are pressed.

3. In view of the said submission made on behalf of the applicants, subject to verification of the dates of discharge of the three applicants and subject to the verification of the nature of discharge of the three applicants mentioned in Paras 4.1, 4.2 and

4.3 of the OA as being on the grounds of the premature voluntary retirement, in view of the order dated 31.01.2025 of this Tribunal in OA 313/2022 read with the order dated 07.02.2025 in OA 316/2025, the respondents are directed to grant the OROP benefits to the three applicants in terms and to the extent granted vide order dated 31.01.2025 in OA 313/2022. OA 3299/2022 is disposed of, accordingly.
